All Entries - Guidelines and Procedures:

1. All entry forms must be received no later than **February 9, 2009**
2. Entries must be (a) quilted, (b) made of fabric, (c) finished, and (d) in good condition.
3. Entries must not have been entered previously in a Foothill Quilters' Guild show.
4. Quilts must have a 4-inch sleeve attached to the top of the back of the quilt. The sleeve should end 1.5 inches in from each side of the quilt.
5. The paper label provided on the reverse of this page must be sewn to the item back on the lower right side. Please sew the label inside garments. * Please use only Paper Labels.
6. Preference will be given to FQG members. Non-member entries will be accepted on a "space available" basis. If necessary, FQG reserves the right to decline the entry based upon membership standing or the number of items entered. You will be notified if your entry is declined.
7. Non-judged entries must be hand delivered with label and sleeve sewn on, **Friday, April 3, 2009** between 8:00 and 11:00 a.m. to the Gold County Fairgrounds, Armory Building, Auburn, CA.
8. Notify us at 530-878-4448 immediately if one or more of your entries must be withdrawn from the show.
9. Entries must be picked up **April 5, 2009** between 4:45 and 5:30 p.m. at the Armory Building, Gold Country Fairgrounds. You must present your receipt to claim your entries.

Judged Entries

1. Judging will take place at Cabin Fever Quilt Shoppe, 826 Lincoln Way, Auburn, CA. Judged entries must be hand delivered to Cabin Fever between 8:00 and 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, April 2, 2009. The Judging Committee will transport judged entries to the Fairgrounds on Friday for hanging. Please do **NOT** bring non-judged entries to Cabin Fever Quilt Shoppe.
2. Judged entries must include \$8.00 per item entered for judging. Make checks payable to FQG.
3. The judge must be able to view the back of the quilt.
4. Judging will be conducted using the "elimination method."
5. First, second and third place awards as well as honorable mention may be awarded in each category.
6. A clerk will be assigned to each judge who will record comments of the judges. The comments will be returned to the exhibitor at the close of the show.

7. Entries will be judged anonymously. A judge shall disqualify himself/herself if there is any possibility of partiality to a particular entry or exhibitor.
8. The judging committee reserves the right to move an entry to a different category or return the judging fee if the entry cannot be judged fairly.
9. Remember, if your quilt is professionally quilted please indicate 2 Person quilt and list all participants

Categories Definitions:

- **TRADITIONAL:** Based on traditional - style patterns.
- **PIECED:** Piecing predominates over appliqué or other technique either in amount or effect.
- **APPLIQUÉ:** Appliqué' predominates over piecing or other techniques in either amount or effect.
- **PICTORIAL:** A quilt that represents a recognizable image of a person, place or thing, may be whole cloth, painted, appliqué', collage or any number of techniques.
- **ART:** Extends beyond the traditional and innovative disciplines, using personal expression and originality in design, color or technique.
- **MINIATURE:** Miniature versions of large quilts. All parts of the quilt should be in proportion, i.e. piecing, quilting, boarders, binding. Quilt should be no larger than 24" x 24".
- **F.Q.G. CHALLENGE:** Foothill Quilters 2009 *Fairy Tale Promise*
- **WEARABLE:** Fashionable & wearable garment constructed using quilting techniques.

- Color photograph of the entry;
- Color photograph of quilter/quilters;
- Signature on the Waiver;
- \$8.00 judging fee if the entry is to be judged.
